Proposed Strategy in Indonesia

- Possible next step in Indonesia,
 - Skills tests are to be <u>organized regularly</u>,
 - Skills tests should be provided open to public,
 - Workers should be trained before the test,
 - New job categories are to be developed,
 - Training facilities should be prepared.
- The expected roles of SESPP are:
 - Technical inputs of <u>skills for automated production</u> near future,
 - Response to the local needs towards <u>skills for mass production</u>,
 - Piloting skills test on a <u>new job category</u>.

 - To expand the number of test takers in response to the needs for skilled workers in Indonesia and overseas,
 - To enhance the quality and brand of BNSP Certification system,
 - To provide training courses as well as facilities for sustainable skill development.
