3. Reviews

<Mr. Koizumi>

The participants had strong consciousness to the implementation of skill competitions. I could see their high motives to competition-related training activities. Moreover, I have a feeling that it would be difficult for Cambodia to hold skills competition unless they proceed as soon as possible with the training of competitors and the development of competitions' guidelines by 2024. For that reason, I would like to request all the participants of this course to hold meetings on a regular basis to discuss and decide, as well as to actively work on equipment procurement in Cambodia. In the case of domestic procurement, they were concerned about the quality of materials. However, it is important to hold the skills competition first, and I think it would be good for them to work on the improvement of the quality and the accuracy each time they organize skills competition.

<Mr. Maeda>

I think it's good that they are seriously working on the competition tasks, but on the other hand, I have a feeling that it would be nice to be serious and have a little more freedom for thinking at the same time. Moreover, I also have a feeling that the participants were too fixated on Japanese-style skills competition. I think that it would be easier to hold the competition if they consider in a way that is a little more in line with Cambodian situation. Besides, I think it's important for the three schools to get together more frequently, such as once every two weeks, and discuss heading towards the implementation of skill competitions.
