2. Review of the course

General review

- In Ho Chi Minh City, the southern region of Vietnam, SESPP implemented its first Skills Evaluation Trial (SET) for Turning 3rd grade in June 2015. This was the third time. In the southern region of Vietnam, we have received a large number of applications for SET from Japanese companies. However, due to the limited number of turning machines at the venue, we are struggling to correspond with it. As a solution for this time, we held four sets of practical skills test for 16 examinees.
- Skills assessors who administered SET this time were composed of ten people. Two of them were certified skills assessors, six of them have completed Skills Assessor Training course and it was their second time to administer SET, and the last two of them joined SET for this first time. Everything went smoothly, and completed four days course without any problems.
- Those six assessors who administered their second SET this time are candidates for Skills Assessor Certificate in November. I inferred that they have sufficient competency as a skills

assessor. If these six assessors are certified as a skills assessor, we can expect that they will play significant roles in implementation of Japanese style skills test with turning 3rd grade in the southern region of Viet Nam.

- According to an expert with JICA Viet Nam, in the southern region of Viet Nam, it is difficult to choose the examinees due to a lot of applicants for turning and mechanical inspection skills test especially from Japanese companies. Hence, in order to fulfill the expectation of Japanese companies, we held practical test four times, instead of three times which we originally planned.
- The number of Japanese companies that have expanded into the southern region is greater than the ones in the Hanoi region. Therefore, demands for skills test are also high. It can be said that it is an appropriate region to develop and spread SESPP. Besides, skills test will be great opportunities for the implementation organization (HVCT) to deepen collaboration with Japanese companies. This can be a very effective opportunities for implementing the internship program and advancing career supports activities.
